



The City of Pickering has completed a Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) study to examine the need for improvements to the existing culvert crossing Sandy Beach Road. This study was conducted in accordance with the Municipal Class EA planning and design process for Schedule 'B' projects.

The completed Project File Report (PFR) is being placed on public record for a 30-day review period in accordance with the requirements of the Municipal Class EA process.

Based on the evaluation of the planning and design alternatives, and considering public and agency input, it is recommended to replace the existing concrete culvert with twin precast concrete culverts.

If concerns regarding this project cannot be resolved in discussion with the City of Pickering, a stakeholder may submit a project review request to the Ministry of the Environment, Conservation and Parks. This is called a Part II Order Request, which is so-named because it invokes Part II of the *Environmental Assessment Act*, allowing the Minister to elevate the project to a higher level of study, if warranted.

If a stakeholder wishes to submit a Part II Order Request, a Part II Order Request Form must be used. The Part II Order Request Form and instructions are available online on the Ministry's website ([www.ontario.ca/page/class-environmental-assessments-part-ii-order](http://www.ontario.ca/page/class-environmental-assessments-part-ii-order)) and the completed form must be received by the Ministry within the 30-day commenting period, following the Notice of Study Completion (by October 26, 2019). If there are no Part II Order Requests by this date, the City of Pickering may proceed with the design and construction. The timing of construction is subject to completion of design and approval of funding by City of Pickering Council.
