Subject: Infill and Replacement Housing in Established Neighbourhoods
Existing Conditions and Preliminary Observations Report – Phase 1

The City of Pickering is undertaking an Infill and Replacement Housing in Established Neighbourhoods Study (the Study) to determine how to manage new infill and replacement housing construction in established neighbourhoods within South Pickering. City staff will present a report providing an update on the status of Phase 1 of the Study to the Planning & Development Committee on April 1, 2019 at 7:00 pm in the Council Chambers.

The staff report recommends that the Phase 1 (Existing Conditions and Preliminary Observations) Report be received and that Council authorize City Development staff to proceed with Phase 2 (Planning Options) of the Study.

The City's consultants, SGL Planning & Design Inc. (SGL), will be presenting an overview of the Phase 1 Report to the Committee.
