

Notice of Electronic Council Meeting

Subject: Comprehensive Zoning By-law Review Phase 2 and 3

The City of Pickering is concluding Phase 1 of the Comprehensive Zoning By-law Review. Phase 1 continued throughout 2020 during which time, staff along with the City's consultant, prepared a public consultation strategy, worked towards the completion of 8 draft discussion papers, hosted an electronic public open house, and published summary documents and videos of the 8 draft discussion papers. Phase 2 will include the preparation of the draft by-law including public consultation, and preparation of a recommended by-law. In early 2022, Phase 3 will be initiated, with the presentation to Planning & Development Committee of the recommended by-law for Council adoption later that year.

A City staff report presenting the key findings and recommendations from the 8 Discussion Papers completed within Phase 1 and comments received from the public and stakeholders, will be considered by **Council on Monday, March 22, 2021 at 7:00 pm**. The City's consultant, WSP, will present an overview of the Discussion Papers at the Council meeting. The Discussion Papers are available for viewing on the project website.

A copy of the City staff report will be available at the office of the City Clerk, and on the City website after 9:00 am on March 19, 2021.

The electronic Council meeting will provide interested parties the ability to learn about the recommendations being considered, and to provide comments. This electronic meeting will be held on:
