Addendum to the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment for Krosno Creek Flood Reduction Study.

The City of Pickering completed the Krosno Creek Flood Reduction Study in February 2015, to establish the most effective means of protecting people and property from the existing flooding along Krosno Creek. The Study Area is shown in the Key Map below.



The Study recommended replacing the existing culverts at Alyssum Street, Reytan Boulevard and Morden Lane, located in the Study Area, with larger concrete box culverts. The Study was conducted in accordance with the Schedule B process as outlined in the Municipal Engineers Association's Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA), October 2000, as amended in 2007 and 2011. A Project File Report was prepared with the Notice of Completion issued on February 18, 2015.

Following completion of the Study, it became evident that the section of Krosno Creek between Reytan Boulevard and Sandy Beach Road requires rehabilitation in order to withstand flows from the proposed culverts and to mitigate ongoing erosion concerns along the creek.

Under the Class EA process, if any significant modifications are proposed to the project after the Class EA Study has been completed, interested parties must have an opportunity to review and comment on the proposed modifications. As such, the City has prepared an Addendum that describes the circumstances necessitating the Krosno Creek rehabilitation.

Feedback can be provided in writing within 30 calendar days from the date of this notice (by May 19, 2017), to Irina Marouchko, City of Pickering.

If concerns regarding the proposed modification cannot be resolved in discussion with City staff, a person or party may request the Minister of the Environment and Climate Change to issue an order for the project to comply with Part II of the *Environmental Assessment Act* (referred to as a Part II Order), which addresses individual environmental assessments.

Requests must be received by the Minister at the address below within 30 days of the Notice, with copies sent to Irina Marouchko, City of Pickering, and the Director of the Ministry of the Environment and Climate Change's Environmental Approvals Branch. If there are no requests received by this date, the City may proceed with design and construction of the project, as per the Addendum.
