Campers coming to Camp with a Parent/Guardian

For the safety of all campers, we ask that you walk your child to the front door of the **West Shore Community Center Entrance** when dropping them off, and to pick them up. Please ensure that you check your child in and out with the designated staff person. This summer, with additional attention to health & safety and security purposes, it is highly encouraged that the same parent/guardian picks up and drops off your camper each day. Please inform the pick-up/drop off staff, should an alternate person be picking-up or dropping-off your child. **Anyone that you have designated as alternate pick up contacts will be required to show Photo ID to camp staff prior to your child being released to their care. Please ensure that they are aware of this protocol.**

WATER DAY AND TIE DYE

Wednesday, August 17th 2022: Dance/Drama Camp will also be participating in Tie-Dye activity! Please pack a white shirt for your camper to tie-dye, labelled with your camper's name if they wish to participate. Please also provide a plastic bag for your camper to store the shirt in, and bring home. **All creations will be sent home, the day of, to allow room for other activities. The activity will take place later in the day, thus the shirt might be still wet.**

Show Day

Friday August 19, 2022: Campers will be preparing for a show throughout the week. We invite parents/ guardians and family to join us for the show at West Shore Community Center on Friday August 19 at 2:00pm.

Absenteeism / Safe Arrivals

If you know ahead of time that your child will be absent from camp, please send a note stating the camper's name and the day that they will be away, or you can call me at the Chestnut Hill Developments Recreation Complex 905.420.4660 ext. 3246. Attempts will be made to contact parents of campers who are absent without prior notification.

Clothing

All campers are advised to wear comfortable clothing that are suitable for a full day of activity. Please avoid wearing jeans and dresses, as it will be hard for your camper to participate in the daily activities at Dance/Drama Camp. Campers are asked **not** to bring valuables to camp, as they will be responsible for their own belongings. Please label campers belongings i.e. lunch bag, extra clothing, coats etc. This helps to avoid confusion when campers misplace their belongings. Also, please send indoor shoes (running shoes would be great!)

Lunches / Snacks

Campers are required to bring their own peanut free lunch with them to camp every day. We also ask that lunches are packed in non-breakable **containers** (no glass). It is recommended that they pack an extra drink and snacks in case they need it throughout the day.

Allergies – Important Notice!

Please be sensitive to any food allergies that may be brought to your attention (i.e. peanut allergies that can be life threatening). For this reason, **Please do not pack peanuts, peanut products, or any products containing traces of nuts in your child's lunches for camp.** If staff are unsure of snacks (i.e. granola bars), campers will be asked not to eat them at camp. Fruit is always a healthy and allergy safe snack! Please feel free to send a copy of the ingredients of any items we may be unsure of (i.e. cookies). Your cooperation is greatly appreciated.
