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Overview

Pickering is committed to creating a community where everyone feels like they belong and will endeavor to be recognized as a designated Age Friendly Community, by the World Health Organization (WHO).

As part of the Age-Friendly Action Plan, the Pickering Age Friendly Steering Committee has worked towards the development of an Adult 55+ Housing Directory. The Directory offers basic information such as contact details, cost, number of units, unit sizes, and level of care; it also provides information about amenities provided at each location and in the surrounding neighborhood.

They say there's no place like home and we couldn't agree more. Home is where you feel safe, supported, it's where the heart is and it is where you are most comfortable. Given this it's no surprise the World Health Organization has identified housing as a major component of an Age Friendly City. They outline Age Friendly housing as affordable, accessible, and sustainable dwellings that meet medical and social needs. In practice, it's having support services available and a space that fosters wellbeing.

This guide is intended to support residents of Pickering, so that they can age in the right place, from home renovations, to moves. Our goal is for it to become a first point of contact to help all those that call Pickering home and who wish to keep it that way.

Aging in Place

Tips for renovations and/or contractors:

The majority of Canadians prefer to age in place however, age related change can create hazards within your home. Taking proactive and precautionary steps can improve the accessibility, safety and livability of your home for years to come. Points to Consider

For Outside:

- Are all of your entrances well lit?
- Do your outdoor stairs, pathways or decks have railings and provide good traction (i.e. textured surfaces)?
- Are the front steps and walkways around your house in good repair and free of clutter, snow, leaves or debris?
- Do the doorways to your balcony or deck have a low sill or threshold?
- Can you reach your mailbox safely and easily?
- Is the number of your house clearly visible from the street and well lit at night?

For Inside:

- Are all rooms and hallways in your home well lit?
- Are all throw rugs and scatter mats secured in place to keep them from slipping?
- Have you removed scatter mats from the top of the stairs and high traffic areas?
- Are your high traffic areas clear of obstacles and debris?
- If you have pets, do you always watch that they are not underfoot?
- If you use floor wax, do you use the non-skid kind?
- Do you have a first aid kit and know where it is, and is it properly stocked?
- Do you have a list of emergency numbers near all phones?

Aging in Place continued

The City of Pickering wants you to 'Build Smart and Build Safe'. When considering renovations or modifications, asking the experts is a great place to start. Be sure to include the Building Services staff at the City of Pickering as one of your experts. Before allowing that first cut or shovel in the ground, be sure to discuss your projects with us, to ensure they're building to the standards of the Ontario Building Code. 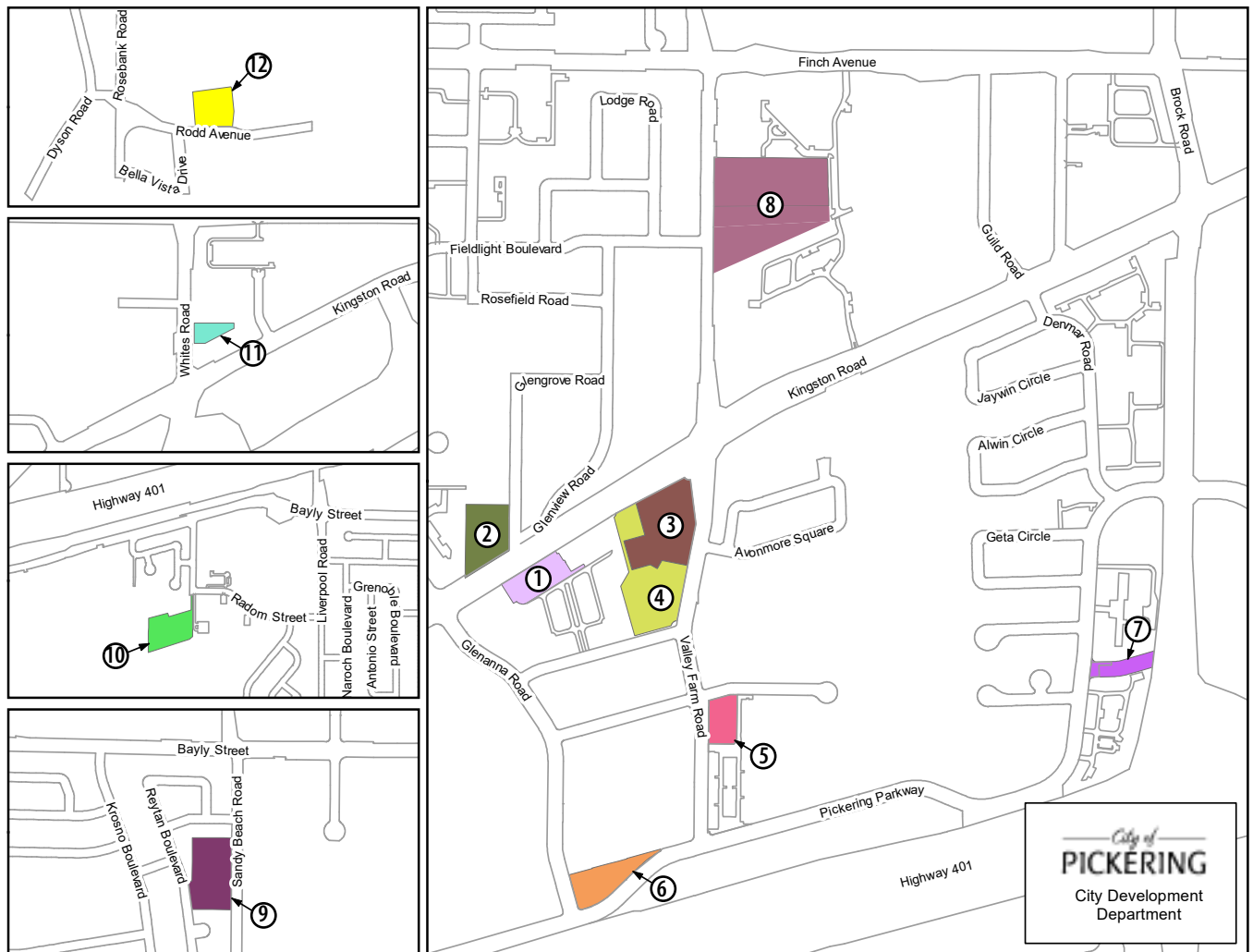
