Campers must be minimum age at start of camp.

Camps are peanut/nut free. Additional sensitivity is requested in regards to any food allergies (potentially life threatening) that may be brought to your attention.

Camp location and activities are subject to change.

Camps that participate in offsite trips will require campers to take a school bus, supervised by camp staff, to and from the trip destination. Complete details on trips and guests will be included in session letters.

*Please note that only camps located at the Chestnut Hill Developments Recreation Complex and Dunbarton High School will be going swimming.

Inclusion Support 4 - 12 yrs

Inclusion support for the City of Pickering's summer camp provides tailored 1:1 assistance to children with special needs, ensuring they can fully participate in camp activities.

Eligibility requires participants to be toilet trained, able to integrate into the camp program with additional support, and adhere to the City's respectful conduct policy. Any behavior that harms staff or participants will result in removal from the program.

Families must complete a Participant Profile to help staff understand how to best support the child and provide necessary accommodations. This support is available exclusively to Pickering residents, and families can apply for support for a maximum of four weeks. Support is not guaranteed and is subject to availability.

The deadline to apply for inclusion support at summer camp is Friday, May 30, 2025


