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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Soil Engineers Ltd. was retained by Highglen Homes Limited to carry out a Phase One Environmental Site Assessment (Phase One ESA) at a property legallay described as Part Lot 33 Concession 2 Pickering, Part 4, Plan #40 R-29767 in the City of Pickering (hereinafter referred to as the 'subject site').

The purpose of the study is to identify any potential environmental concern associated with the subject site. The findings from our research of documents pertaining to the subject site, interviews with persons knowledgeable of the subject site, and an environmental site reconnaissance, together with our assessment, are presented in this report.

Throughout the years, the subject site was historically used for agricultural purposes, and has been vacant since some time between 1992 and 2007. The neighbouring properties consist of residential properties to the south, east and west, and vacant land to the north and northeast.

The Phase One ESA did not reveal any items of environmental concern attendant to the subject site.

A Phase Two Environmental Site Assessment (Phase Two ESA) is not warranted at the subject site.



INTRODUCTION

Soil Engineers Ltd. (SEL) has carried out a Phase One Environmental Site Assessment (Phase One ESA), as defined by the Environmental Protection Act (EPA), Ontario Regulation (O. Reg.) 153/04, as amended by O. Regs. 366/05, 66/08, 511/09, 245/10, 179/11, 269/11 and 333/13, hereinafter referred to as O. Reg. 153/04 for a property legally described as Part of Lot 33, Concession 2, Part 4, Plan # 40 R-29767 in the City of Pickering, Ontario (hereinafter referred to as the subject site).

2.1 Phase One Property Information

The subject site, as shown on the Site Location Plan, Drawing No. 1, is located on the north side of Finch Avenue and approximately 300 m west of Altona Road, in the City of Pickering. The subject site is comprised of one (1) Property Identification Numbers (PIN) 26370-0370 (LT), as shown on the Property Index Map, (Block 26370), Drawing No. 2.

The property information obtained from the Parcel Register and land transfer documents, and the UTM coordinates obtained from Google Earth are given in the table below:

The subject site is irregular in shape, encompassing an approximate area of 0.51 ha (1.27 ac).

SCOPE OF INVESTIGATION

The general objectives of a Phase One ESA, as defined by Part VII of O. Reg. 153/04 of the EPA, are the following:

- To develop a preliminary determination of the likelihood that one or more contaminants have affected any land or water on, in or under the subject site.
- To determine the need for a Phase Two Environmental Site Assessment (Phase Two ESA).
- To provide a basis for carrying out any required Phase Two ESA.
- To provide adequate preliminary information about the environmental conditions in the land or water on, in or under the subject site, in order to conduct a risk assessment following the completion of a Phase Two ESA, if required.

A Phase One ESA generally consists of the following components:

- A records review.
- Interview(s).
- Site reconnaissance.
- An evaluation of the information gathered from the records review, interviews and site reconnaissance.
- Completion of a Phase One ESA report.
- The submission of the Phase One ESA report to the commissioner of the report.

This Phase One ESA was commissioned in support of a proposed residential use development. It is anticipated that the new development will be provided with municipal services meeting urban standards.



RECORDS REVIEW

4.1 General

(i) Phase One Study Area

Except where noted, the Phase One Study Area generally consists of the subject site plus 250 m beyond the perimeter boundaries of the subject site.

(ii) First Developed Use

The first developed use of the subject site is defined by O. Reg. 153/04 as the earlier of either the first use in or after 1875 that resulted in the development of a building or a structure on the subject site, or the first potentially contaminating use or activity on the subject site.

A Historical Map dated 1877 was located at the McGill University Canadian County Atlas Digital Project website on December 3, 2019. A copy of the map is presented on Drawing No. 3, showing that the subject site was part of the estate owned by T. Barnett at that time. Based on the shape and size of the estate, the subject site was most likely used for agricultural purposes.

(iii) Fire Insurance Plans

A search for fire insurance plans was conducted at the Toronto Reference Library on December 16, 2019. No fire insurance plan is available for the subject site or the Phase One Study Area.

(iv) Chain of Title

A land title search was conducted for the subject site at the Ontario Land Registry Access website on December 3, 2019.



The information from the Parcel Register and Land Title research is listed in Appendix 'A'. The earliest records show that the subject site was part of Lot 33 Concession 2 in the Township of Pickering. Due to illegibility of early chain of title records, the ownership can not be traced to the Crown. The subject site was part of the land owned by Mr. John Henderson from 1890s to 1909.

Throughout the researched years, the land was subdivided, with the ownership of the subject site changing several times between private individuals and the Crown. The most recent transaction for the subject site is listed in the table below:

(v) Environmental Reports

No previous environmental reports were provided for the subject site.

4.2 Environmental Source Information

(i) Ministry of the Environment, Conservation and Parks (MECP)

MECP Waste Disposal Sites

Active and closed landfill sites located in excess of 1 km from the subject site are considered to have no significant potential for environmental impact on the subject site. On December 5, 2019, SEL reviewed the Ontario MECP "Waste Disposal Site Inventory", dated June 1991. There are no waste disposal sites located at the subject site or within 1 km of the subject site.



Industrial Sites Producing or Using Coal Tar and Related Tars in Ontario

On December 4, 2019, SEL reviewed the MECP "Inventory of Industrial Sites Producing or Using Coal Tar and Related Tars in Ontario", dated November 1988, and the "Inventory of Coal Gasification Plant Waste Sites in Ontario", dated April 1987. There is no record of any coal gasification plant, coal tar distillation plant, creosote plant, etc., at or within 1 km of the subject site.

Polychlorinated Biphenyls (PCB) Waste Storage Sites

The MECP "Ontario Inventory of PCB Storage Sites", dated October 1991 and April 1995 respectively, were reviewed on December 4, 2019. The subject site is not listed as a PCB waste storage site, and no PCB waste storage site is located within the Phase One Study Area.

MECP Waste Generator

On December 4, 2019, the MECP Waste Generator Registration database files, dated 2000, 2008, 2013, 2015 and 2018, were reviewed. No waste generators are registered at the subject site, however, five (5) records were found for a property located within the Phase One Study Area. Details are listed in the table below:

Records of Site Condition (RSC)

On December 5, 2019, the MECP public Brownfields Environmental Site Registry was reviewed for RSCs filed for the subject site or within the Phase One Study Area. No record was found for the subject site and one (1) record was



found for properties located within the Phase One Study Area. Details are listed in the table below:

No Certificate of Property Use was attached to the RSC.

MECP Freedom of Information

A request for documented environmental concerns and citations pertaining to the subject site was forwarded to the MECP Freedom of Information Office on December 5, 2019. No response has been received at the time of writing this report. In the event that their response suggests cause for concern, it will be forwarded together with an assessment of its significance. A copy of the request is included in Appendix 'B'.

(ii) Environment Canada

National Pollutant Release Inventory (NPRI)

On December 5, 2019, the Environment Canada NPRI database files were reviewed. The subject site is not registered in the NPRI database and no properties within 1km of the subject site boundary are listed in the database.

National PCB Inventory

On December 3, 2019, the Environment Canada PCB Inventory database files, dated 1994, were reviewed. The subject site is not registered in the National PCB Inventory database. In addition, no property within the Phase One Study Area is



listed in the database.

(iii) Other Sources

Municipal Freedom of Information

The City of Pickering no longer processes Freedom of Information Requests for environmental concerns, therefore no municipal Freedom of Information Request was sent.

Technical Standards & Safety Authority (TSSA)

The use of underground storage tanks (USTs) and above-ground storage tanks (ASTs) containing petroleum products is regulated in Ontario by the Ministry of Consumer and Commercial Relations (MCCR) under various legislative instruments, including the Gasoline Handling Act and Energy Act. ASTs and USTs that contain petroleum products are required by law to be registered with the MCCR, and the TSSA is responsible for keeping records of these tanks. Customer Services of the TSSA was contacted on December 2, 2019, regarding possible registration, size and age of USTs and ASTs pertaining to the subject site. On December 3, 2019, they informed us that they had no records for the listed properties. It should be noted that TSSA records are only reliable from 1987 to the present. A copy of TSSA response is included in Appendix 'C'.

Environmental Risk Assessment Service (ERIS) Ltd.

ERIS Ltd. provides reports that compile information from both government and private databases of interest to the environmental field. The ERIS Report for the subject site, dated November 26, 2019, is presented in Appendix 'D'. The notable records pertaining to the subject site and the Phase One Study Area are listed in the table below:

Certificates of Approval (CA)

No CA was issued for the subject site and four (4) Certificates of Approvals were issued for a property located within the Phase One Study Area. All of the CAs pertain to Municipal and Private Water and Sewage Type. Based on the nature of the type of approvals, this type of approvals are considered to have a low potential to influence the environmental condition of the subject property. For details of records, please see Appendix 'D'.

Environmental Compliance Approval (ECA)

No Environmental Compliance Approval was issued for the subject site and four (4) ECAs were issued for a property located within the Phase One Study Area. All approval records are municipal water or sewage type. Based on their nature, these records are considered to have a low potential to influence the environmental condition of the subject property. For details of records, please see Appendix 'D'.

Ontario Regulation 347 Waste Generators Summary (GEN)

O. Reg. 347 of the Ontario EPA indicates that waste generation is considered to be equipment and/or operation which involves production, collection, handling, and/or storage of regulated wastes. The O. Reg. 347 Waste Generators Summary is a database which contains the registration number, company name and municipal address of registered waste generators.



The ERIS report indicates that there are no waste generator records for the subject site, however, there are ten (10) waste generator records pertaining to a property within the Phase One Study Area. Details of the records are listed in the table below:

TSSA Historic Incidents (HINC)

The TSSA maintains a database of all fuel related incidents in Ontario, i.e., pipe line breaches, gas leaks, etc. According to the ERIS report, there is no HINC record for the subject site, however, there are three (3) records pertaining to strike to natural gas pipelines on construction sites within the Phase One Study Area. Reportedly, no damage occurred as a result of any of the incidents. Based on their nature, these incidents are considered to have low potential to influence the environmental condition of the subject property. For details of records, please see Appendix 'D'.

Fuel Oil Spills and Leaks (INC)

According to the ERIS report, there is one (1) INC record for the Phase One Study Area. A 1/2-inch service/riser distribution pipeline was hit approximately 226 m southwest of the subject site at 120 Finch Avenue. No further details are provided in the ERIS report. Based on the transgradient location of the incident and distance separating the location from the subject site, this incident is considered to have low potential to influence the environmental condition of the subject site.



Record of Site Condition (RSC)

RSC is part of the Ministry of the Environment's Brownfields Environmental Site Registry. According to the ERIS report, no RSC is registered for the subject site and one (1) RSC is registered for a property located within the Phase One Study Area. The details of the record are listed below.

Scott's Manufacturing Directory (SCT)

Scott's Manufacturing Directory, a voluntary and comprehensive database of manufacturers in Ontario, contains information of company addresses, plant sizes and products produced by manufacturers. There no records for the subject site, however, there are two (2) records pertaining to properties within the Phase One Study Area. Details of the records are listed in the table below:

Ontario Spills (SPL)

Information such as the location (approximate), type and quantity of contaminant, date of spill, environmental impact, cause, nature of impact, etc. are recorded in the database from 1988 to 2011. One (1) spill incident is listed in the database for a property within Phase One Study Area. The incident was related to natural gas pipeline leak and therefore considered to have low potential to influence the environmental condition of the subject



site. For details of records, please see Appendix 'D'.

4.3 **Physical Setting Sources**

(i) Aerial Photographs

Aerial photographs were found at the City of Burlington Interactive Maps website on September 6, 2018 and obtained from Environmental Risk Information Services (ERIS). A review of the aerial photographs, dated 1954, 1969, 1988, 1998, 2002, 2008 and 2017, indicates that the subject site has been mainly used for agricultural purposes. Copies of the aerial photographs are presented in Appendix 'E'. A review of the aerial photographs is summarized in the table below:

(ii) Topography, Hydrology, Geology

Maps of the area were located at Natural Resources Canada and the Ontario Ministry of Natural Resources (OMNR) on November 26 and December 3, 2019. An Ontario Base Map and a Topographic Map were available for our review, showing the land features at those dates. Copies of the maps are presented on Drawing Nos. 4 and 5, respectively, showing that the subject site was vacant and a water body (a creek) was located east to northeast of the subject site. As well, a roadway was located adjacent to the south side of the subject site. A chronological review of the maps indicates land features of the subject site are consistent with those shown on the aerial photographs. Based on the topography of the area and close proximity to the water body, precipitation runoff on the subject site is expected to flow in a southeasterly direction.

Geological maps of the area were located at the Ontario Geological Survey and the Bedrock Geology of Ontario Database on November 26, 2019. A surface geology map is presented on Drawing No. 6, showing that the subject site is underlain predominately by Halton Till Material, which consists of predominantly silt to silty clay matrix. A bedrock geology map is presented on Drawing No. 7 showing that the subject site is underlain by bedrock of Georgian Bay Formation, Blue Mountain Formation, Billings Formation, Collingwood Member, Eastview Member (shale, limestone, dolostone and siltstone).

The subject site is located in the larger hydrogeological region known as Southern Ontario Lowlands. A watershed map of the area was located at the Land Information Ontario website on November 26, 2019. A copy of the map is presented on Drawing No. 8. The map indicates that the subject site is situated within the Petticoat Watershed.

According to the Ontario Geological Survey Bedrock Cross Section Viewer, accessed on November 26, 2019, the bedrock at the subject site is overlain by approximately 52 m of drift.



(iii) Fill Material and Topsoil

There is no documentary evidence to suggest that fill material is present at the subject site.

(iv) Water Bodies and Areas of Natural Significance

Ontario Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry

SEL reviewed the Ontario Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry (OMNR) Natural Heritage Information Centre (NHIC) database on November 26, 2019 for listings of the various classes of natural areas located in the vicinity of the subject site. According to the database, a water body (Petticoat Creek) is located approximately 30m to the east of the subject site and Provincial Wetlands are located approximately 100 m to the south of the subject site. Wooded areas are present to the north, east and south of the subject site. A copy of the Natural Features and Protection Area Plan is presented on Drawing No. 9.

Planning Authorities/Wellhead Protection Areas

The Source Water Protection Information Atlas was reviewed on December 12, 2019. Based on our review, the subject site is not located within a Wellhead Protection Area.

(v) Well Records

The MECP's Water Well Information System dataset available for download at their website was reviewed on November 26, 2019 regarding the subject site and the surrounding area. No wells are located at the subject site. Ten (10) wells are located within the Phase One Study Area. A copy of the MECP Well Record is presented in Appendix 'F'.



4.4 Occupancy Search

An occupancy search for the subject site and Phase One Study Area was conducted at the Toronto Reference Library on December 17, 2019. No records were found for the subject site or properties located within the Phase One Study Area.

4.5 Records Review Summary

A summary of the relevant information disclosed by our records review as of December 17, 2019, is given below:

- The subject site was historically used for agricultural purposes. (Sources: Aerial Photographs)
- A property management services company Geritts Property Services with associated waste generator records was located approximately 77 m southwest of the subject site at 169 Finch Avenue. (Sources: MECP, ERIS)
- A garden supplies company Paterson Garden Supplies Ltd. was located approximately 150 m to the east of the subject site at 200 Finch Avenue. (Sources: ERIS)
- According to Scott's Manufacturing Directory database, a graphic design services company One Plus One Productions Inc. was located approximately 200 m east of the subject site at 154 Nature Heaven Crescent. (Sources: ERIS)
- Railway tracks are located approximately 156 m north of the subject site.
 (Sources: Maps)
- A creek is located approximately 30 m to the east of the subject site.
- Provincial Wetlands are located approximately 100 m to the south of the subject site. (Sources: Maps)
- The subject site is adjacent to two roadways (Finch Avenue to the south and Nature Heaven Crescent). (Sources: Maps and Aerial Photographs)



5.0 **INTERVIEW**

An interview questionnaire was sent to High Glen Homes Limited which is the current owner of the subject site since. The questionnaire was completed by the owner's representative Mr. John Perciasepe. To the best of his knowledge, he is not aware of any underground storage tanks, dumping of hazardous substances or petroleum products or other major environmental concerns related to the subject site. A copy of the completed questionnaire is included as Appendix 'G'.

5.1 Summary of Interviews

The interview did not disclose any item of environmental concern with regards to the subject site.



6.0 SITE RECONNISSANCE

6.1 General

A visual inspection of the subject site and the publicly accessible areas of the Phase One Study Area was conducted by our representative, Ms. Vrunda Modi, Environmental Technician, on December 10, 2019 to determine the general environmental condition of the subject site. The conditions and time of the site visit are presented in the table below:

Site photographs taken during the inspection are presented in Appendix 'H'.

At the time of the inspection, the subject site consists of vacant land. The subject site is located on the north side of Finch Avenue and east side of Nature Heaven Crescent in the City of Pickering. The neighbouring properties consist of residential properties to the south, east and west, and vacant land to the north and northeast.

The ground surface at the subject site is relatively flat. There was no visible sign of any underground tank, excavated pit, and sump. There was no noticeable nuisance odour, stained soil or stressed vegetation observed in any area of the subject site. There was no evidence to suggest that materials of environmental concern are disposed on the subject site.

6.2 Specific Observations at Phase One Property

(i) Building Inspection

At the time of the site inspection, there are no buildings or structures at the subject



site.

(ii) Hazardous Materials

Our representative checked for the presence of hazardous materials such as asbestos-containing materials (ACMs), polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs), ureaformaldehyde foam insulation (UFFI), ozone-depleting substances (ODSs), mercury and lead-based paints. Based on our visual inspection of the subject site, there is no evidence to suggest that any of these hazardous materials are used, stored or disposed at the subject site.

(iii) Underground Storage Tanks (USTs)

There is no vent or filler pipe visible to indicate the presence of USTs at the subject site.

(iv) Above-Ground Storage Tanks (ASTs)

There was no indication of any ASTs on the subject site.

(v) Substance Containers

Our representative checked for the presence of substance containers such as oil drums, used oil containers, gasoline jerry cans, paint cans, etc. At the time of our inspection, these items were not observed at the subject site.

(vi) Waste Management and Maintenance Practices

No waste is generated at the subject site.

(vii) Air Quality and Noise

During our inspection, there was no offensive odour or detectable source of air



emissions that may impact the ambient air quality at the subject site. No unexpected noise level greater than the ambient is noted at the subject site. In this case, ambient noise includes the noise of traffic along Finch Ave and Nature Heaven Crescent which is adjacent to the subject site.

(viii) Water Wells

No water wells were observed at the subject site at the time of the site reconnaissance.

(ix) Phase One Study Area Inspection

Based on our visual inspection of the publicly accessible areas, the neighbouring properties consist of residential properties to the south, east and west, and vacant land to the north and northeast.

(x) Enhanced Property Investigation

There is no industrial processing, dry cleaning service, or chemical manufacturing or handling carried out at the subject site at the time of this Phase One ESA. No record of such activities in the past was recovered for the subject site during our search. Therefore, no enhanced property investigation was conducted.

6.3 Summary of Site Reconnaissance

Our site reconnaissance, conducted on December 10, 2019 has revealed the following items which warrant further discussion:

 The subject site is adjacent to two roadways (Finch Avenue and Nature Heaven Crescent).



7.0 REVIEW AND EVALUATION OF INFORMATION

7.1 Current and Past Uses

The records review indicates that the subject site was mainly used for agricultural purposes, and has been vacant since 1992. A description of the major uses of the subject site and the year in which they appear to have commenced is presented in the Table of Current and Past Use, Appendix 'J'.

7.2 Discussion of Environmental Items

Based on our review of records, interviews and site reconnaissance, as of December 16, 2019, the following information pertaining to the environmental condition of the subject site has been disclosed by the Phase One ESA:

- The subject site was used for agricultural purposes. (Sources: Records Review)
- Railway tracks are located approximately 156 m north of the subject site. (Sources: Records Review)
- A property management services company Geritts Property Services with associated waste generator records was located approximately 77 m southwest of the subject site at 169 Finch Avenue. (Sources: Records Review)
- A garden supplies company Paterson Garden Supplies Ltd. was located approximately 150 m to the east of the subject site at 200 Finch Avenue. (Sources: Records Review)
- According to Scott's Manufacturing Directory database, a graphic design services company One Plus One Productions Inc. was located approximately 200 m east of the subject site at 154 Nature Heaven Crescent. (Sources: Records Review)
- A creek is located approximately 30 m to the east of the east of the subject site.
- The subject site is adjacent to two roadways (Finch Avenue to the south and Nature Heaven Crescent). (Sources: Maps and Aerial Photographs)



(i) Potentially Contaminating Activity

A Potentially Contaminating Activity (PCA) is defined by O. Reg. 153/04 as a use or an activity that is occurring or has occurred in a Phase One Study Area, as per Table 2 of Schedule "D".

We have evaluated the risk associated with specific items in the above list to determine the potential for that activity to impact the environmental condition of the subject site.

Agricultural Use of the Subject Site

Based on our records review, the subject site was historically used for agricultural purposes, and has been vacant since some time between 1992 and 2007. It is possible that pesticides may have been used at the subject site. Since the subject site has been vacant over a considerable period of time, in our opinion, the pesticides would have dissipated over the time. Therefore, the historical use of the pesticides is considered to have a low potential to influence the environmental condition of the subject site, as such it is not considered as a PCA.

Railway Tracks to the North

Based on our records review, railway tracks are located approximately 156 m north of the subject site. Based on the distance separating railway tracks from the subject site, the presence of railway tracks is considered to have a low potential to influence the environmental condition of the subject site. #46 Rail Yards, Tracks and Spurs

Neighbouring Property Services Company

Based on our records review, a property management services company Geritts Property Services with associated waste generator records was located



transgradient, approximately 77 m southwest of the subject site at 169 Finch Avenue. Taking into account the transgradient location and the distance separating the neighbouring property from the subject site, the property management services company is considered to have a low potential to influence the environmental condition of the subject site, and this activity is not considered a PCA.

Neighbouring Garden Supplies Company

Based on our records review, a garden supplies company Paterson Garden Supplies Ltd. was located approximately 150 m to the east of the subject site at 200 Finch Avenue. Taking into account the distance separating the neighbouring property and its transgradient location, the garden supplies company is considered to have low potential to influence the environmental condition of the subject site, and therefore, it is not considered a PCA.

Neighbouring Graphics Design Company

According to our records review, a graphic design services company One Plus One Productions Inc. was located approximately 200 m west of the subject site at 154 Nature Heaven Crescent. Based on the transgradient location and the distance separating the property from the subject site, the operation of the graphic design company at the neighbouring property is considered to have a low potential to influence the environmental condition of the subject site, and therefore, it is not considered a PCA.



(ii) Other Environmental Items

Areas of Natural and Scientific Interest (ANSI), Environmentally Sensitive Area (ESA) and Water Bodies

Based on our record review and site reconnaissance, a water body Petticoat Creek is located approximately 30 m east of the subject site.

Adjacent Roadways

The subject site is adjacent to two roadways (Finch Avenue to the south and Nature Heaven Crescent). This is of concern due to the de-icing chemicals used during the winter season which may result in higher than usual levels for the Sodium Adsorption Ratio and Electrical Conductivity of the soil. If the soil remains in situ, it is considered to meet the standards through clause 49 (1) of O. Reg. 153/04.

7.3 Areas of Potential Environmental Concern (APEC)

Based on our review of the activities identified at the subject site and Phase One Study Area, there are no APECs identified at the subject site.

7.4 Phase One Conceptual Site Plan

A Phase One Conceptual Site Plan illustrating the findings and results of the assessment is presented on Drawing No. 10.



8.0 **CONCLUSIONS**

Soil Engineers Ltd. was retained by Highglen Homes Limited to carry out a Phase One Environmental Site Assessment at a property located at a property described as Part Lot 33 Concession 2 Pickering, Part 4, Plan #40 R-29767 in the City of Pickering (the subject stie). The neighbouring properties consist of residential properties to the south, east and west, and vacant land to the north and northeast.

8.1 Phase Two Assessment Recommendation

The Phase One Environmental Site Assessment (ESA) did not reveal any items of environmental concern attendant to the subject site.

A Phase Two Environmental Site Assessment (Phase Two ESA) is not warranted at the subject site.

8.2 Record of Site Condition (RSC) Requirements

We understand that the subject site will be developed for residential use. Given the type of development proposed for the subject site, an RSC is not required to be filed in accordance with Ontario Regulation 153/04, as amended.

Please note that if there is an intent to file an RSC, in accordance with O. Reg. 153/04, any environmental reports including a Phase One ESA must be dated within 18 months of the date of filing.

8.3 Environmentally Sensitive Area (ESA), Body of Water, Areas of Natural and Scientific Interest (ANSI)

A water body Pettticoat Creek is located approximately 30 m east of the subject site. A survey needs to be carried out to ascertain the exact distance from the subject site to the



boundary of Petticoat Creek.

In the end the Creek is located within 30 m of the subject site, it may be prudent to segregate the lands within 30 m of this watercourse. This is subject to municipal and regional approval. Doing so will reduce the area that will be subject to the stricter criteria used when developing on or near ESAs, a body of water, or ANSIs.

8.4 Legal Requirements

If an RSC has been submitted and filed, the property owner must retain a copy of this report for at least seven (7) years in accordance with O. Reg. 153/04, Section 18.

The objectives and requirements as set out in the O. Reg. 153/04, as amended, for a Phase One ESA were applied in carrying out the environmental site assessment and in the preparation of this report.


