Successful applicants will possess strong communication and customer service skills, and meet the following criteria to be considered for either position:

- Enrolled in secondary school education or any acceptable combination of education, training and related experience.
- Previous related experience working with children, or as a Lifeguard, is considered an asset.
- Standard First Aid and CPR-C issued after August 15, 2022, or enrolled in a course or recertification that will be successfully completed by August 15, 2025.
- Applicants must be medically and physically fit to perform the duties of the position.
- Must be willing to obtain certification in High Five – Principles of Healthy Child Development.
- Must be prepared to undergo a Vulnerable Sector Check as a condition of employment.
- The ability to work various shifts, including evenings and weekends.
- Must be able to attend all mandatory Staff Training in September (dates to be confirmed).
