

## **Notice of Electronic Statutory Public Meeting**

### **Regarding the City's Proposed New Development Charges By-law**

Take notice that the Council of the City of Pickering will hold an electronic statutory public meeting pursuant to The *Development Charges Act, 1997*, regarding proposed development charge rates and policies that will be applied in the City (including Seaton). It is proposed that the enactment of a new Development Charges By-law by Council would occur on July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2025. The public meeting will be held on:

#### **Monday, June 9<sup>th</sup>, 2025 (immediately after the Executive Committee Meeting)**

Development Charges (DC) are levied against new development and are a primary source of funding growth-related capital expenditures.

City Council is required under The *Development Charges Act, 1997*, to hold at least one public meeting to allow the public the opportunity to review and provide comments on the 2025 Development Charges Background Study, and the proposed DC By-law.
