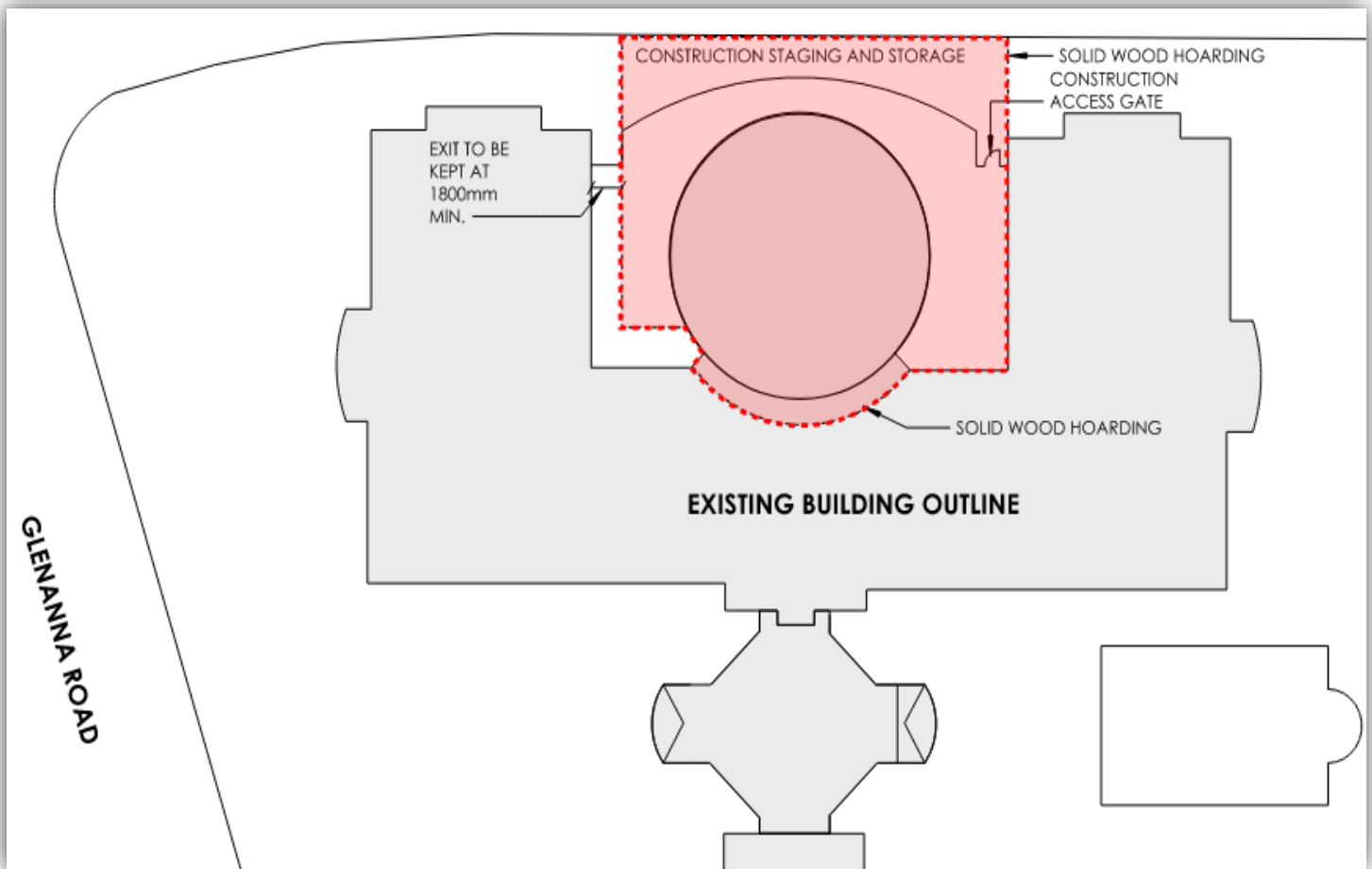

Service Disruption at Pickering Civic Complex' Council Chamber

Purpose: Extension of Council Chamber Renovation

Duration: Monday, August 11, 2025 to Friday, August 28, 2026

Construction for the Council Chamber Renovation commenced on August 11, 2025 and will continue until project completion on August 28, 2026. During this time, the Council Chamber will remain closed.

The area around the Chamber inside the Civic Complex lobby continues to be blocked off by hoarding to allow the renovation of the wall between the Chamber and the lobby. An exterior area around the Chamber will also remain blocked off for safety and is reserved for the General Contractor's use. Please refer to the plan below for the approximate construction area.



Dust and noise mitigation measures remain in place; however, occasional disruptions may still occur. Whenever feasible, service interruptions and particularly disruptive work will be scheduled outside of regular hours to minimize impact.

The area within the construction barriers will be an active construction site under the control of the City's contractor. Only authorized personnel may enter, under the supervision of the contractor, and only while wearing all required personal protective equipment (PPE). Limited street parking on the north side of the Civic Complex will be reserved for the use of the General Contractor (three spaces), as outlined below.
